

PCCW Meeting Minutes

October 3, 2018

Opening

The regular meeting of the PCCW was called to order at 10:05 a.m. on October 3, 2018. Eighteen (18) members were present.

Approval of Minutes: Minutes of the September meeting were read and approved.

Financial Report: Marilyn Guy reviewed the financial report and stated the Men's donation from the Spring rummage sale went to Delmina Woods.

Vice President: Nancy Thomas reviewed up-coming events: Oct 12-14th Craft Fair at Our Lady of the Lake, Oct 10th Rummage Sale Meeting at 10am, Oct 25-27th Fall Rummage and Bake Sale and reminded all to check the bulletin for details and set-up dates.

Parish Council Report: Sister Charlotte reported the first draft of the Parish Safety Plan has been distributed to Parish Council Members and Project Connect served 408 individuals and there is a good possibility it will be repeated next year. A guest speaker event is being considered during Advent, Fr. Dave to co-ordinate.

Unfinished Business:

Nancy Loughner. and Trudy Krueger. completed the PCCW audit. Men's choice of charity was Delmina Woods. The men are looking into the cost of renting a larger storage unit for rummage sale items .

New Business:

The PCCW Christmas party and gift exchange will be at the Wagon Wheel. The gift exchange will include "My Favorite Christmas Thing" (under \$5) and a Secret Santa Gift also under \$5 to be purchased at rummage sale or thrift store or something from home . The Parish Christmas Potluck Party will be coordinated

by Kathy Strader , Gardis Ohlson , Nancy Moore and Fran Melton. CAM will host Festival of Trees at the Landing and are looking for volunteers. Please call Betty McKenzie if interested in volunteering. Mike Stenger is willing to cut out wood ornaments if the women would like to trace the pattern. Mike donated items for the craft fair. A motion was made to give Mike \$50 for the wood he purchased making items. Vote taken, motion passed.

The Fall Rummage & Bake Sale in 2019 will be moved to September. This years rummage sale meeting will be held on October 10 at 10am. Karl Krueger will make breakfast for those arriving by 7:30am during rummage sale set-up; Oct 15 - 23rd. Nancy Thomas to coordinate lunches. A motion was made to approve \$300 to purchase food items needed for lunches. Vote take, motion approved. A new vaccum and push broom are needed, motion made to approve \$125, vote taken, motion approved. Jan Dougherty will not be able to assist with jewelry this year, Fran Melton and Charlene Hartley volunteered. Jerry Strunk will break down boxes on Saturday. A sign-up sheet for kitchen duty will be posted. Flyers need to be distributed. Dorothy Baker will take and post pictures to Facebook. Pie filling for pies can be brought in. Un-packing will start on Saturday, October 13th at 8:00am. Tables will be set up on Friday, October 12th. The Taney Times is not responding to phone calls and the Forsyth office is closed. A live radio ad will run during the week of the sale. Marking pens to check legitimacy of bills \$20 and larger will be in each cash box. A discussion was held regarding the acceptance of checks. It was decided to accept checks with identification and documentation. We received two bad checks from one individual during the Spring sale. Marilyn Guy will post the name inside the cash boxes. We will not accept checks from this individual. Darlene Bissell inquired about Numana. Sister Charlotte stated it was a community event headed by the Presbyterian church. They are seeking volunteers to assist with packaging items on October 6th.
